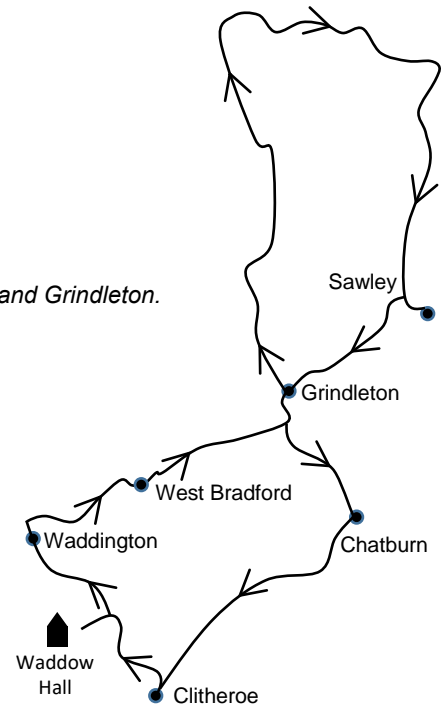

(TAKE CARE: blind corner)
→ *Follow the road over the bridge and up the hill back to Waddow Hall*
